

NOTICE

Pursuant to the Kentucky Public Service Commission's ("Commission") regulation 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8, Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (RECC) gives notice that tariffs requesting approval to modify the service charges for temporary service will be submitted to the Commission on December 12, 2017. If Nolin RECC's requests are approved, the tariff will be effective January 12, 2018, at which time the rates set below will be implemented for all new applicants requesting temporary service:

Each service with a cooperative-owned temporary pole will see a total increase of \$225 based on a five-month average deployment. Each service with a member-owned temporary pole will see a total increase of \$65. A person may examine these tariff filings upon request at the Nolin RECC office located at 411 Ring Road, Elizabethtown, KY 42701. A person may also examine these tariff filings at the Commission's office located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or through the commission's Web site at <http://psc.ky.gov>. Comments regarding these tariff filings may be submitted to the Commission through its Website at <http://psc.ky.gov>, or by mail to Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602. The rates contained in these tariff filings are the rates proposed by Nolin RECC, but the Commission may order rates that differ from the proposed rates contained in these tariff filings. A person may submit a timely written request for intervention in these tariff filings to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, establishing the grounds for the request and including the status and interest of the person requesting intervention. If the commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of this notice, the Commission may take final action on the tariff filings.
