Participation Requirements: **High School:** _____

1. Students must be a senior with intentions of graduating in the spring of 2018 and planning to enroll full-time in college or vocational school.
2. Participants must be from the Nolin RECC service area and their parents or legal guardian must be a Nolin RECC member whose primary residence is in the Nolin RECC service territory.
3. Previous Nolin RECC scholarship winners, Nolin RECC employees, directors, or anyone receiving direct benefits from Nolin RECC, and members of their immediate families, are not eligible for any Nolin RECC scholarship awards.
4. One scholarship in the amount of \$2,500 will be awarded based on the following criteria:

Grade Point Average (25%)

Community and Personal Achievements (15%)

School Involvement (15%)

Legitimate Financial Need (45%)

Recipient must use scholarship within two (2) years of receiving the award.
