Winners announced for Washington Youth Tour
Nolin RECC to send 5 local high school students on trip in June

Nolin RECC has announced the winners of the Washington Youth Tour sponsored by Nolin RECC, Kentucky Electric Cooperatives and the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA). This trip to Washington, D.C., is awarded to five high school juniors whose parent(s) or guardian(s) receives electric service from Nolin RECC.

The winners this year are Molly Hobbs (Homeschool), Elizabeth Pepper (Central Hardin High School), Ellee Price (LaRue County High School), Braden Shearer (Elizabethtown High School) and Hailey Turiczek (Dupont Manual High School). High school juniors applied for this program and were selected by committee based on a review of a submitted essay, their knowledge of Nolin RECC and cooperatives, and an in-person interview.

These students will spend June 17-23, 2022 learning about the United States government, touring museums and monuments, and meeting with Kentucky's congressional delegation.
