

Nolin RECC Solar Contractor/Member Requirements

#1. Nolin RECC must receive and approve the completed NET metering tariff before construction of the array is to begin by the member or solar installation contractor. Please email any submissions and correspondence to the email below.

The Nolin RECC NET metering must be signed by the member. Specific installation requirements are available in the tariff. Utility disconnect, labeling, insurance requirements, inspections, etc.

#2. All NET metering submissions will be approved for construction via email. An example of the approval email sent to the installer is below.

“The NET metering submission at 1234 Brown St. Elizabethtown, KY is approved. 5.8 KW inverter with a 7.3 KW array. Please keep me posted on the install and when it nears time for interconnect, I will need a few days’ notice to change the meter that is presently in the socket to a NET meter. If you have any questions let me know. **Please do not leave the array powered after the installation until *after* P&Z has performed the electrical inspection and we have changed the meter to a NET meter.** We will change the meter presently at this account to a NET meter once we receive the electrical inspection from P&Z.

Also, we strongly advise pulling all necessary Planning and Zoning permits BEFORE beginning the installation process. Each individual county or city Planning and Zoning jurisdiction may have individual or unique requirements. These P&Z requirements are not affiliated with the Nolin RECC requirements for interconnect to the grid. Certain array configurations may or may not be permitted in some county or city Planning and Zoning areas. It is up to the contractor to contact the P&Z office to properly permit the installation before work begins. “

#3. The existing meter at the account will be changed once Nolin RECC receives the electrical inspection from Planning and Zoning. After meter exchange the solar contactor or member will receive an email granting permission to operate the array. On site commission testing is not required but will occur if the installer or member request an on site commission test by Nolin RECC.

#4. Nolin RECC encourages our members to contact Nolin RECC before installing an array. This will allow Nolin RECC to explain to our members billing and payment of the NET metering rate. At no time are NET metering credits converted to cash value. An explanation of billing and payment for NET metering accounts are in the NET metering tariff that is signed by the member.
