Winners announced for Washington Youth Tour
Nolin RECC to send 5 local high school students on trip in June

Nolin RECC has announced the winners of the Washington Youth Tour sponsored by Nolin RECC, Kentucky Electric Cooperatives and the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA). This all-expense-paid trip to Washington, D.C., is awarded to five high school juniors whose parent(s) or guardian(s) receives electric service from Nolin RECC.

These students will spend June 12-17, 2023 touring The Smithsonian Institution, Arlington National Cemetery, the FBI Building, the National Zoo, Library of Congress, U.S. Capitol, the Kennedy Center, plus a visit with Kentucky's congressional delegation.
